



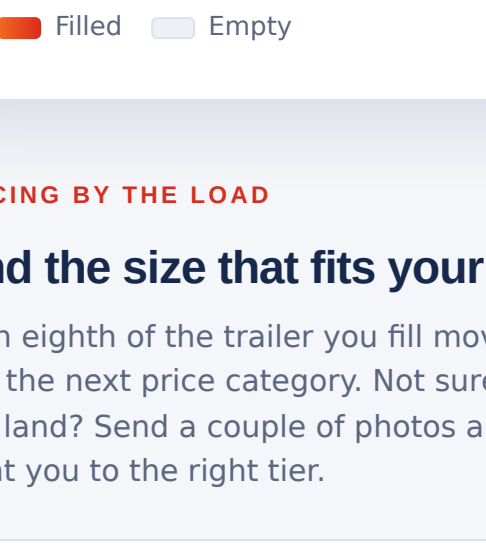

How we figure the price

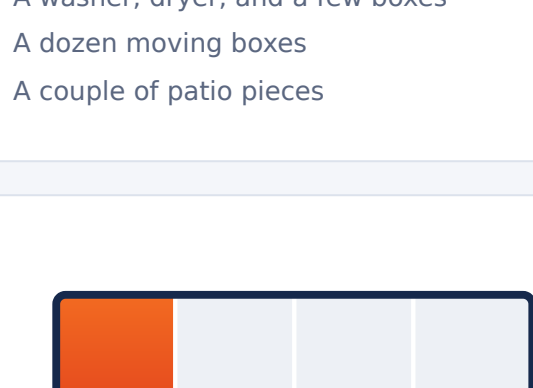
We divide the space in our 14-foot trailer into eighths and base your cost on how many eighths your load takes up — from a small 1/8 up to a packed 8/8. The numbers below show the range for each tier; the final figure is set once we've seen the job.

PRICING BY THE LOAD

Find the size that fits your job

Each eighth of the trailer you fill moves you into the next price category. Not sure where you land? Send a couple of photos and we'll point you to the right tier.



1/8 Load

~1.75 cu yd

\$99–\$149

The quick grab — one thing or a small pile (rides in our F-250 bed)

- A single recliner or sofa
- A mattress and box spring
- An old TV and a small desk
- A few boxes and bags



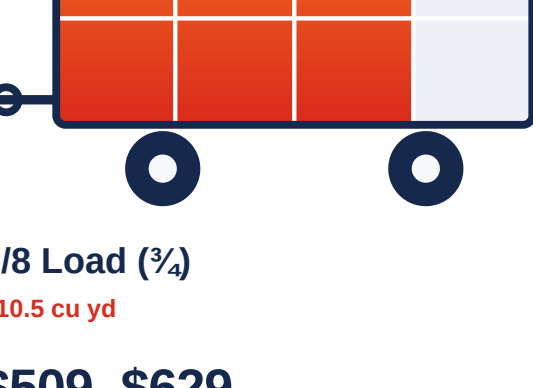
2/8 Load (quarter)

~3.5 cu yd

\$199–\$249

A corner of a room, or a few big pieces

- A small bedroom's furniture
- A washer, dryer, and a few boxes
- A dozen moving boxes
- A couple of patio pieces



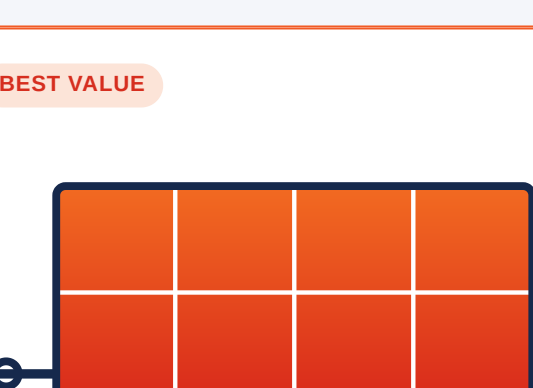
3/8 Load

~5.25 cu yd

\$269–\$349

A room's worth of furniture

- A living room of furniture
- A bedroom set plus boxes
- A home office — desk, chair, cabinets
- A 5x5 storage unit



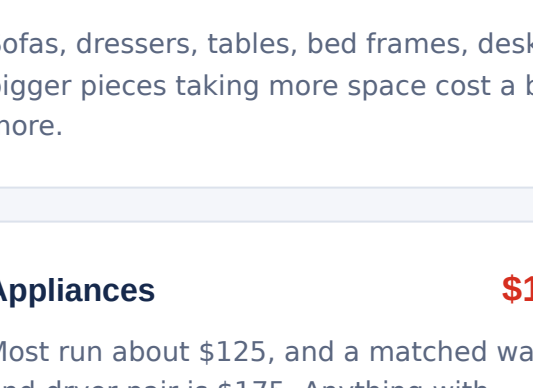
4/8 Load (half)

~7 cu yd

\$349–\$429

A couple of rooms, or a half garage

- A half-full one-car garage
- Two rooms of furniture
- A small basement
- A deck of old furniture



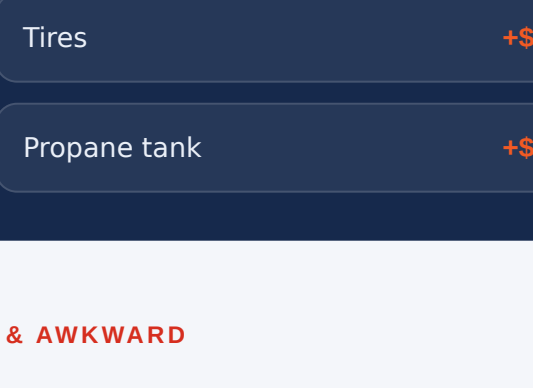
5/8 Load

~8.75 cu yd

\$439–\$529

A cluttered garage or partial basement

- A cluttered one-car garage
- A finished basement, partial
- Two or three rooms of furniture
- A big spring-cleaning haul



6/8 Load (¾)

~10.5 cu yd

\$509–\$629

Several rooms, or a whole basement

- A full finished basement
- Three or four rooms of furniture
- A packed one-car garage
- A small apartment's furniture



7/8 Load

~12.25 cu yd

\$599–\$709

Almost a full trailer

- A small apartment, nearly all of it
- A packed two-car garage
- Four or more rooms of furniture
- A 5x10 storage unit

BEST VALUE



8/8 Load (full)

~14 cu yd

\$679–\$799

The whole place

- A full one-bedroom apartment
- An estate, room by room
- A two-car garage, cleared out
- A whole renovation's debris

These are starting numbers, not final ones. Once we see your items, we provide a single set price we hold to. We also point out any special-disposal items before we begin.

ONE OR TWO THINGS

Smaller pickups

Got just a piece or two? Single pickups begin at \$99, and the exact figure tracks the size of the item and the room it takes.

Furniture \$99+

Sofas, dressers, tables, bed frames, desks — bigger pieces taking more space cost a bit more.

Appliances \$125+

Most run about \$125, and a matched washer-and-dryer pair is \$175. Anything with refrigerant — fridge, freezer, AC — starts at \$150, since the law requires draining the coolant.

Mattresses \$99–\$139

From \$99 for a twin or full, \$119 for a queen, \$139 for a king; add on \$30 for a box spring.

PASS-THROUGH FEES

A few items cost extra

Some things cost us more to drop off — anything with refrigerant, mattresses, electronics, tires. We add that exact landfill fee to your total with nothing on top, and we always say so before it goes on the truck.

Mattress / box spring +\$30

TV / electronics +\$30

Tires +\$20

Propane tank +\$15
